Antigua and Barbuda's Pepperpot and Fungee MUST appear on the nominated establishment's weekly menu.

All nominated establishments will be recognised.

JUDGING OF ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA'S BEST PEPPERPOT AND FUNGEE COMPETITION

Rules and Regulations

- (1) Every participant must show proof of food handlers training by a recognized organization.
- (2) Participants must be employed by the entity which they are representing for a minimum of three months prior to the competition.
- (3) The local cuisine being presented must be a weekly Menu item.
- (4) For the preliminary round participants are required to bring 8 already prepared appetizer size portions for judging, to the Antigua & Barbuda Tourism Authority John E. St. Luce Finance and Conference Centre, St. John's, Antigua. Judging takes place on **May 13 at 1:00 p.m.**
- (5) ALL participants must be at the judging location at least HALF AN HOUR prior to the start of the competition.

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(6) Participants are required to keep their portions warm until their time of judging.

- (7) All presentations must be in clean, hygienic, and acceptable containers.
- (8) The preliminary round will be conducted in a blind tasting format by a discerning panel of international and nationally recognised chefs and cultural food experts.
- (9) The top 4 establishments will on **May 17** receive a visit to their business location by the judging panel for a second taste-test of the establishment's pepperpot and fungee dish. The judges will adhere to the criteria provided, and it is from here a winner will be decided.
- (10) The organizers will not be responsible for loss or breakage of any items utilized by chefs during the competition.
- (11) All ingredients needed for this competition will be provided by the participating restaurants/ cook shop.
- (12) The organizer of this event reserves the rights for usage of all imagery, recipes and content produced during and for the organization of this event.

CRITERIA:

The judges will be looking for an Antigua and Barbuda flavour profile, taste, texture, technique and creativity in presentation, and will from the criteria.

The winner will be announced at the end of Antigua and Barbuda Restaurant Week.
